

MEMBER OF 52 ND. DIES OF PNEUMONIA

FIRST DEATH AMONG THE
TROOPS MOBILIZING AT PORT
ARTHUR FOR OVERSEAS
SERVICE—MILITARY BURIAL

The first death among the overseas troops mobilizing at Port Arthur took place at St. Joseph's hospital at 2.30 this morning when Private Lafontaine died of pneumonia. Private Lafontaine formerly came from Ottawa. He was twenty-six years of age. The funeral will be held at 3 p.m. Sunday from the hospital, with military ceremonies. Rev. Father Donovan will conduct the religious services.
