

Returning Soldiers

The steamship Regina docked at Halifax on Sunday, March 30. The officers on board included Lieut. G. F. Gibbon, Fort Frances; Lieut. F. L. Thomas, Port Arthur; Lieut. C. J. Short, Kenora.

Pte. D. Palm, of Port Arthur, was one of the wearers of the Military Medal ribbon among the party. He was originally with the 141st battalion and won his M. M. last August. He has been wounded twice.

Pte. F. Michon, also from Port Arthur, also won the M. M. He went overseas with the 52nd battalion and has been twice wounded. He won his decoration in 1916.

On board the Regina were many prisoners of war, including several of the 8th battalion men who have served over three years in German camps. Pte. J. N. Goodwin, of Fort William, who went overseas with the 141st battalion, was one of them. He was captured in October, 1917, and was held for thirteen months.
