

LOCAL VETERANS FAVOR CALGARY RESOLUTION

Largest Meeting of G.W.V.A. Ever
Held Here—59 New Members
Initiated.

At the most largely attended meeting in its history in Fort William, the great war veterans' association last night adopted, by a large majority, and after a lengthy discussion which lasted for an hour and a half, the Calgary resolution, relating to

war bonus for the men who have served in the Canadian army during the great war. The Calgary resolution asks for a grant in cash of \$2,000 for men who have seen service in France, \$1,500 for all men who reached England, and \$1,000 for all men doing service in Canada.

Over three hundred war veterans attended the meeting and fifty-nine new members were initiated by President W. C. Millar.

A resolution sent in by the Winnipeg branch of the G.W.V.A. in reference to the alien question was unanimously adopted.

Other matters of importance were dealt with and it is felt that this branch is well on its way to becoming one of the finest branches of the association in the Dominion. The members display keen interest in all matters of importance to the welfare of the country and the empire for which they fought.
