

ANOTHER BOOK ABOUT THE 52ND BATTALION SOON TO BE ON SALE

A new book will shortly be placed on sale in the book stores of the twin cities and elsewhere, being a historical record of the 52nd battalion, and its movements from the time it left Canada until its return in March last.

It will be profusely illustrated with half-tone photos, and also cartoons by Moyer.

The compilation of the work has been done by Sergeant F. Willisten La Soeur, a graduate of Austin University Texas, a member of the 52nd battalion, who was attached to the battalion for some time as official recorder.

The book will be placed on sale shortly at a popular price and will consist of three hundred pages, well bound, and will, no doubt, meet with a ready sale.

This will be the second book issued on the exploits of the 52nd battalion, W. C. Miller, president of the great war veterans association here, and well-known as the author of the "Fighting 52nd," having disposed of many hundreds of copies of his work, which was issued a few months ago.
