

# TWO CITIES LEAD IN STAMP SALES

---

**BUT PORT ARTHUR SCHOOLS  
ARE BEHIND THOSE AT  
FORT—SOME FIGURES.**

Port Arthur and Fort William lead all the west in sale of War Saving Stamps. Since the inauguration of the movement these two cities have bought over \$15,000 worth. Regina is next with over \$6,000. Saskatoon bought \$5,200, and Moosejaw \$4,800. In the district race Fort William still heads the list with \$10,674. Port Arthur is coming from behind with an increase of \$1,059.25 over last week, making a total of \$7,449.25. Eleven business places have entered the 100 per cent. society class.

In the school shield competitions the Fort William pupils have forged away ahead of Port Arthur. The Fort William school total is \$2,085.50. The Port Arthur total is \$918.60. The total includes both public and separate schools. The Port Arthur separate schools have a total of \$303.50 and the public schools \$487.25.
