

Under the auspices of the great war veterans, a memorial service will be held in the Royal theater on Sunday next at half past two in the afternoon, to commemorate the anniversary of the second battle of Ypres, which commenced on April 22nd, 1915, and through which the Canadian first division was continually engaged until May 24th, when they were withdrawn and relieved. All returned men are asked to attend this service and to parade in uniform. The services will be conducted by Rev. J. A. Cranston, assisted by other clergy of the city.
