After an absence of more than four years, Private Thomas Burk, son of Mrs. D. F. Burk, has returned from overseas service. He enlisted on August 8, 1915, and went overseas with the Port Arthur company of the original Eighth battalion, and, after a short service in the battle area was taken prisoner, together with his brother Gerry and other Port Arthur men on April 28, 1916. He was for many months at the German prison camp at Muenster, and afterwards transferred to Linden where he remained until the signing of the armistice, when he was repatriated. Private Burk returned to Canada a couple of weeks ago but visited points in the east before coming on to Port Arthur.
