John left here with the 28th, and was wounded slightly, returned in 1917 and joined the aviation corps in Toronto. He had a leg broken in a crash. The father of these two young men enlisted with the 94th, and was seriously shell-shocked, from the effects of which injuries he died in Winnipeg.
