

# SALE OF THRIFT- STAMPS IN SCHOOLS

The official report issued from the secretary's office of the Thunder Bay division of the national war savings committee, gives the total sales to May 31 of thrift stamps in Port Arthur to be \$11,786. Of this amount the schools contributed \$2,321.

This result has entailed considerable work on the part of the teachers, and a good deal of enthusiasm from the pupils, backed by loyal support from the parents.

An appeal has been sent out to make an even bigger effort in June, so as to bring sales to as near the amount asked for by Sir Herbert Ames, national chairman, as is possible.
