PTE. CHARLES J. McCULLOUGH

Father W. F. McCullough, of St. Agnes' R. C. church, West Fort, has received word that his brother, Private Charles Joseph McCullough, died at the Canadian military hospital, Eastbourne, England, Saturday, May 10th. Private McCullough was making preparations to return to Canada when taken ill. He was thirty years of age and was born at Lonsdale, Ontario. When he enlisted for overseas, Private McCullough was studying for priesthood. He had been

attending college at Buffalo and Boston, but returned to Canada and enlisted with the infantry forces at Kingston. He is survived by five brothers:—Father Dan McCullough, of McCook, Neb.; Mr. Henry McCullough, of Lonsdale, Ontario; Mr. John McCullough, of Marmora, Ontario; Mr. James McCullough, of Ridgetown, Ontario; and Father W. F. McCullough, of West Fort William. Requiem high mass for the late Private McCullough will be sung Friday morning at 9 o'clock in St. Agnes' church.
