COMES BACK HOME

Owen Sound "Original First" Worked
His Way Up—Without a wound

Owen Sound, May 18.—One of the latest arrivals here is Lt.-Col. Wil-
lard P. Malone, who returned to Ca-
nada last week with the 15th Batta-
lion. He is one of the "Original Firsts"
from Owen Sound, having joined the
local quota to the 15th as a lieuten-
ant early in August, 1914. The follow-
ing spring he went to France and
served there up till March, 1917. In
that time he received promotions up
to a major, and after attending a
Senior Officers' training school at
Aldershot was placed in command of
the 208th Battalion, with the rank of
Lt.-Col. Later he received a staff ap-
pointment in England, and went to
Corps Headquarters in France in
September of last year. Although he
had many narrow escapes he came
through the war without a wound,
and is receiving a warm welcome on
his return to his home town.
