

SALE OF THRIFT STAMPS IN SCHOOLS

The Separate Schools continue to hold the lead in the sale of Thrift Stamps school contest, their sales amounting to \$531.25 up-to-date. Room 8 of St. Andrew's School is credited with the nice amount of \$161.75, while Room 6 has sold \$93 worth.

Prospect Avenue school with \$367.-25 still leads the public schools but the "prospect" ahead is that Central School with \$361 will soon catch up. Two weeks ago Central School was \$186 behind Prospect School. Today the difference is only \$6.25.

The number "80" is much in evidence, this week, thus:

Room 10 (Central)	88.50

The number "70" also has a live appearance, thus:

Room 11 (Central)	\$75.25
Room 7 (Central)	71.25

Room 2 in South Ward leads the school with \$48.25. Room 7 of North Ward likes "40," too, for her total is \$40.50.

The total of sales in all the schools is beginning to assume creditable proportions. During the months of February, March and April, the sales amounted to \$1037 in all schools. The number of Thrift Stamps sold during the first three weeks in May amount to \$844. If the last week's sales total \$193, May's sales will equal the total sales of February, March and April.
